PRIVACY AND TERMS OF USE

We all care about how our personal information is used or share, so we take your privacy very seriously. By visiting the Pixellato Website [*pixellato.com*] you are accepting the terms and practices outlined in this policy.

1. Information Collection

We only collect personal information that is relevant to the purpose of our website. This information allows us to provide you with a customized and efficient experience, and also to promote your work.

2. Information You Provide Us

We receive and store any information you enter on our website or provide to us in any other way. You can choose not to provide us with certain information, but then you may not be able to take advantage of many of our special features.

- i. Registration information. In order for you to use Pixellato's services you must complete a registration form. As a part of this registration form, we require select personal information.
- ii. User profile. To allow you to express yourself beyond the just the registration information, we may enable you to provide additional information, such as bio, favorite URLs, and instant messaging IDs. In addition, you may choose to include photos of yourself in your profile. As indicated below, in the section titled "Sharing your Information", you can control how your information is displayed.

3. Automatic Information

We receive and store certain types of information whenever you interact with us. Pixellato and its authorized agents automatically receive and record certain traffic data on their server logs from your browser including your IP address, Pixellato cookie information, and page you requested. Pixellato uses this traffic data to help diagnose problems with its servers, analyze trends and administer the website.

4. Email Communications

Pixellato is very concerned about your privacy and we will never provide your email address to a third party without your explicit permission, as detailed in the “Sharing Your Information” section below. Pixellato may send out emails with Pixellato-related news, products, offers, surveys or promotions. You may also receive notification emails from Pixellato, which inform you of actions (e.g. friend/follow requests) that have been performed on the site. If you do not want to receive emails from us, please visit the Email Preferences section of your User Profile and/or follow the instructions in the email message for unsubscribing. However, please note that in all cases you will continue to receive all system emails (e.g. those regarding forgotten user passwords, etc.) and legal notices (e.g. updates to our policies) from us.

5. Cookies

Cookies are alphanumeric identifiers that we transfer to your computer through the web browser to enable our systems to recognize your browser and tell us how and when pages in our website are visited and by how many people. Pixellato cookies do not collect personal information.

The “Settings” or “help portion of the toolbar on the majority of browsers will direct you on how to prevent your browser from accepting new cookies, how to command the browser to tell you when you receive a new cookie, or how to disable cookies. Some of our business partners, like advertisers on our site, may use cookies on our website and Pixellato is not responsible for such cookies; however, cookies are safe.

6. Sharing Your Information

Because Pixellato enables people to discover and share information with one another, information about the people who use Pixellato is an integral part of the Pixellato experience. Rest assured that we neither rent or sell your personal information to anyone and that we will share your personal information only as describes below.

Pixellato Personnel. Pixellato Personnel and authorized consultants and/or contractors may have access to user information if necessary in the normal course of Pixellato business.

Business Acquisition or Transfers. In these types of transactions, user information is typically one of the business assets that is transferred. Moreover, if Pixellato, or substantially all of its assets, were acquired, user information would be one of the assets that is transferred.

Legal Bindings and Others. We may release personal information when we believe in good faith that the release is necessary to comply with a law; to enforce or apply our Terms of Use

and other policies; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of Pixellato, its employees, users and others. This includes exchanging or sharing information with other companies and organizations for fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

User Profile Information. Information collected during registration and subsequent visits, such as your full name and location, may be displayed to other Pixellato users on your User Profile. The User Profile is the area on Pixellato where we allow you to express to other Pixellato users about yourself. You may control what personal information is displayed in your User profile by visiting the Settings section of your User Profile.

Syndication. Pixellato allows for the RSS syndication of all its public content within the Pixellato website.

With Your Consent. Except as noted above, we will contact you when your personal information is shared with third parties or used for a purpose incompatible with the purpose(s) for which it was originally collected, and you will be able to opt out to prevent the sharing of this information.

7. Keeping Information Secure

Your Pixellato information is protected by an encrypted password for your privacy and security. Protect against unauthorized access to your password and to your computer by logging off once you have finished using a shared computer.

Only employees who need personal information to perform a specific job (e.g. a customer service representative) are granted access to it. All our employees are kept up to date on our privacy and security practices.

8. Ways to Control Display and Use of Your Information

As stated previously, you can always opt not to disclose information, but then you may be unable to use certain features of our website.

By visiting your User Profile, you can correct, amend, add or delete personal information on our website.

9. Users Under 18 Years of Age

You must be 14 years and older to register to use the Pixellato website. We recommend that minors between the ages of 14 and 18 ask and receive their parents' permission before registering at or using Pixellato or sending/sharing information about themselves on Pixellato.

10. Changes to the Privacy Policy

Pixellato may amend this Privacy Policy from time to time, at its sole discretion. If we make changes to the Privacy Policy, we will notify you by posting an announcement on the Pixellato website so that you are always aware of what information we collect, and how we may use it, and under what circumstances if any, it is disclosed.

11. Conditions of Use

If you decide to visit the Pixellato Website, your visit and any possible dispute over privacy is subject to this Privacy Policy and our Terms of Use, including limitations on damages, arbitration of disputes, and application of respective law.
